

Custom Case Template Instructions

To craft a pouch for devices similar to an iPod Touch, follow these directions for drafting a custom template. Use our original iPod Touch template as a visual reference, and reference Country Living's 2012 December-January issue for complete crafting instructions.

STEP ONE Place your device on a piece of printer paper, and trace around it with a pencil to create the front template. Trace around your device again on the same piece of paper (space permitting) or on another sheet of paper, to create the back template.

STEP TWO Using a pen and a straight-edge ruler, draw a line 1/16-to 1/8-inch (depending on the thickness of the device) around the outside of the pencil line on both the front and back template to create a stitch line. Curve the line evenly at the corners.

STEP THREE Using a pencil and a straight-edge ruler, draw a line 3/16-inch around the outside of the pen line to create the cut line for both the front and back templates.

STEP FOUR Using scissors, and following the cut line, cut out each template.

STEP FIVE Shorten the top area of the front template as shown on the original iPod Touch template by cutting the top section at the pencil line, rounding the corners and cutting vertically 1/4-inch past each curve. Cut horizontally in from the outer edges of the template to meet the vertical cuts.

STEP SIX Now that your template is complete, refer to Country Living's December-January (2012/2013) issue for leather transfer and sewing instructions.
